



11. STUDENT DISCIPLINE AND REFERRAL PROCEDURES

It is to be recognised that L2W students are likely to generate some behavioural problems on occasion. Although behaviour that may place themselves and/or others in danger is not to be tolerated, staff are expected to demonstrate a degree of tolerance and adopt a constructive approach that should lead to improvement. It is important that there should be a thorough dialogue between school and provider where disciplinary matters arise. Similarly, there needs to be an open debate with the student and their parents/carers. The aim should always be to resolve the dispute to the satisfaction of all parties. It is strongly recommended that the Referral Process shown within Appendix D is followed.
